Dear Parent(s) or Guardian(s):

Across the nation, families of eligible children under the age of 19 **with or without** private health insurance coverage are enrolling their children in the **free** Children's Health Insurance Program known as CHIP.

The South Dakota Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) provides free health insurance coverage for eligible children under the age of 19 **without** private health insurance whose family's adjusted monthly income is less than **\$4,564 a month** for a family of four, or **\$54,768 a year**.

The South Dakota Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) also provides free health insurance coverage for eligible children under the age of 19 **with** private health insurance whose family's adjusted monthly income is less than **\$4,083 a month** for a family of four, or **\$48,996 a year**.

The health insurance program provided by the South Dakota Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) includes the following **free services** for eligible children: Physician Services, Hospital Services, Vision Care, Dental Care, Prescription Drugs, Medical, Dental, and Vision Screening, Chiropractic, Mental Health, Durable Medical Equipment, and Other Medical Services.
