

Last Week of School for Seniors

- May 16th and 17th - Semester Tests
 - For those who do not earn an "A" for the semester
- May 18th
 1. Academic Awards program 9:00am (grades 6-12)

 3. Graduation practice will begin about 11:30am once the band is set up
