Parent Involvement Policy

In compliance with the October 20, 1994, Improving America's Schools Act for Title I Programs, Section 1112, the Parker Elementary School District 60-4 will comply with the spirit of this law which states:

“Any LEA that receives Title I funds shall develop jointly with, agree upon, and distribute to, parents of participating children, a written parent involvement policy that is incorporated into the local educational agency's plan.”

To implement this policy the Parker Elementary School Title I Program will:

1. Notify parents when a child has been selected to participate in the Title I program and explain why the child has been selected.
2. Invite all parents of participating children to an annual fall meeting to explain the Title I Program and make them aware of parental involvement requirements.
3. Add comments to the classroom progress reports that are sent home.
4. Inform each child's parents of the specific learning objectives and methods for their child at the regular parent-teacher conference.
5. Encourage parents to participate in the Title I Program and provide opportunities for their involvement.
6. Provide parents of participating children and other interested parents with timely information about the program by sending home the Title I monthly newsletter, which includes learning activities to complete at home.
7. Make a copy of this policy and other pertinent information available to Title I parents.
8. Give parents a survey in May to evaluate the Title I services available to them. Summarize the results of this survey for the end-of-year report that will be mailed to parents.
9. Provide activities to promote educational enrichment of their children at home, if requested by the parent.
